

About the DeBary Science Scholarship

The DeBary Science Scholarship is a one time (non-renewable) scholarship award for a total of \$2,000.00 (U.S.). Award funds will be disbursed to the award recipient's student account after they notify us of enrollment in a qualified university program. Funds may be used for any fees or expenses that are payable from your student account.

Eligibility

Students must meet the following eligibility requirements to qualify for this scholarship.

- 1. Students must have continuously lived at an address within the DeBary, Florida City limits since at least November 1, 2023.
- 2. Student must have a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 or higher during high school and must provide an official transcript.
- 3. Student must enroll in a four year science program at an accredited university in the United States by December 31, 2024.
- 4. Student must submit an application and all required supplementary documentation no later that April 30, 2024.

Instructions

- 1. Complete all applicable sections of the application (white areas of the application if printing; blue shaded areas if filling out in Adobe Acrobat). Type or print responses on the application. The application can be filled out using Adobe Acrobat Reader (https://get.adobe.com/reader/) and submitted as a .PDF file, or printed. - 2. Enclose the following items in a large envelope, or email electronic copies to: scholarship@debaryscholarship.org
 - a) The completed application below.
 - b) An essay consisting of 1000 to 1500 words. In the essay, describe what you believe are the opportunities and impacts presented by recent expeditions to the moon. The essay may be hand written or typed, and will be evaluated on the basis of originality and vision. You may submit the essay as a Microsoft Word document, a LibreOffice Writer document, a text file, a .PDF file, or in the body of an email. The essay can be sent via email to scholarship@debaryscholarship.org or mailed as described below.
 - c) One letter (or email) of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, principal, or vice principal at your school.
 - d) A current, <u>official</u> high school transcript. Instructions for obtaining your official transcript can be found on the Volusia County Schools website at https://www.vcsedu.org/records-management/verifications. If you have attended other high schools, please include official transcripts from those schools as well.
 - e) Optionally, you may include any additional documents such as test scores, letters from educators or community leaders, awards, or other documents that speak to your academic potential and community service.



3. Completed applications and electronic documents must be emailed to scholarship@debaryscholarship.org no later than the deadline of midnight April 30, 2024.

Alternatively, you can mail the completed application packet to DeBary Scholarship Foundation, postmarked no later than April 30, 2024.
